

The motion was agreed to without a dissenting voice and, with some slight changes, became Article VIII of the report of the Committee of Detail of the 7th of August, which in turn became the linch-pin of the Constitution. * Then, on the 27th of August, it was agreed that the jurisdiction of the Supreme Court should extend to all cases arising under the laws passed by the Legislature of the United States, whether, that is, such laws should be in pursuance of the Constitution or not. The foundation was thus laid for the Supreme Court to claim the right to review any state decision challenging on constitutional grounds the validity of any act of Congress. Presently this foundation was broadened by the substitution of the phrase judicial power of the United States for the phrase jurisdiction of the Supreme Court, and also by the insertion of the words this Constitution and the before the word laws in what ultimately became Article III of the Constitution. The implications of the phraseology of this part of the Constitution are therefore significant: * Article VI, paragraph 2. Section I. The judicial power of the United States shall be vested in one Supreme Court, and in such inferior courts as the Congress may from time to time ordain and establish. The judges, both of the Supreme and inferior courts, shall hold their offices during good behavior, and shall at stated times receive for their[.].
